Bevan Foundation	£39,130	To campaign to prevent homelessness by changing the level of Local Housing Allowance and by improving its interface with the Welsh housing system.
Bristol Refugee Rights	£36,000	To establish Bristol as the leading city in the UK in the campaign to ameliorate and abolish No Recourse to Public Funds restrictions and use this as a catalyst for change.
Expert Link	£27,350	Harnessing the skills of people with lived experience of multiple disadvantages to improve access to the benefits system.
Homeless Link	£49,697	In partnership with NACCOM, develop a powerful shared roadmap to improving the local support offer for people with No Recourse to Public Funds facing homelessness and generate qualitative and economic evidence to support the national case for the suspension of the NRPF condition.
IPPR	£36,450	To advocate for reforms to ease the pressures created by the welfare system for those most at risk of being left behind by long-term unemployment.
Learning & Work Institute	£49,419	To raise awareness and secure change to improve the support that care leavers receive through the welfare system.
Money and Mental Health Policy Institute	£33,394	To push for an improved third party access process in Universal Credit, ensuring people - particularly those experiencing mental health problems - who would benefit from the practical support of a friend or family member can get the help they need.
Public Law Project Ltd	£44,826	To reduce unfairly or wrongly applied sanctions by identifying strategies to tackle barriers to appeal, enabling more people to challenge the DWP.
Z2K (Zacchaeus 2000 Trust)	£49,834	To lead a strategic push for fundamental reform of the Government's disability benefits assessments that galvanises disabled and seriously unwell people; including responding to and influencing the forthcoming Green Paper.
